In the hopes of clearing up some confusion with regards to the disposal of corrugated cardboard boxes please see the Paper Items recycling information listed below. Corrugated boxes should be put out on Paper/Cardboard recycling date, not on Bulk Trash day. Recycling bins & collection calendars are available at Village Hall for residents. The monthly calendar is posted on our website www.chestnutridgevillage.org.

PAPER ITEMS

<u>Recycle</u>: newspaper, junk mail, magazines, telephone books, catalogues, brown paper grocery bags, office paper, paperback books, cereal boxes (wax coated insert must be removed and placed in with garbage.)

Paper items must be tied together or in a reusable container, which can be obtained from the Village. Do not place paper items in with co-mingled items. Your container will not be picked up. Tied bundles of paper or container of paper must not exceed 40 lbs. Plastic bags are prohibited.

Cardboard: Corrugated boxes must be flattened and tied. Tied bundles must not exceed 40 lbs.

<u>Do Not Recycle</u>: Wrapping paper, chipboard, and wax coated paper, wax coated cardboard, wax coated insert from cereal box, shoe box, pizza box. These items are regular garbage.

In addition all recycling must be curbside by 6:00 am. Recycling may also be put out curbside after 6:00 pm the evening before, if necessary.

It is imperative that these rules are adhered to; the Village has specific contract terms with its carter, and proper recycling helps generate revenue for the Village to keep taxes as low as possible.
