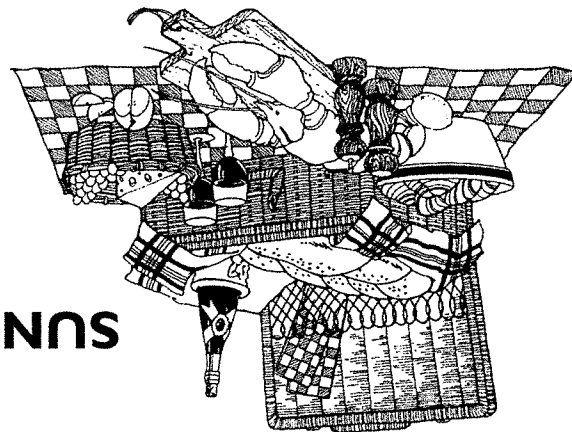
“THANK YOU”

No Parking on Village Roads: November 1st through April 1st between the hours of 12 a.m. and 6 a.m.

Reminder to residents and private contractors not to throw snow in middle of roadway when clearing driveways and walkways; this creates a safety hazard and the Ramapo Police can issue a violation for doing so.

As winter approaches, if you have a storm drain or fire hydrant near your home, please try to keep it free from snow.

- **Please pick up waste from your dog.**
- **Please make sure your house number is displayed on your home: good for safety ... and required by Village regulations.**
- **Please walk single file on roads when dusk or dark; you may not be seen when wearing dark clothing.**
- **Please wear yellow safety sashes; they are available in Village Hall.**

GARBAGE/TRASH REGULATIONS

Just a reminder to our residents ...

GARBAGE must be placed out for collection on the evening before or no later than 6:00 AM on your collection day.

TRASH COLLECTION:

TRASH must be placed at curbside on the evening before or no later than 6:00 AM on the scheduled collection day.

TRASH found at curbside on any day but the second scheduled pick-up day (or after 6:00 PM the night before) could be subject to a fine.

TRASH BAGS should not exceed 30 lbs. LEAVES must be placed in paper bags and left curbside. Paper bags are available at Village Hall free of charge; there is a limit of 10 bags per visit.

BRANCHES AND TWIGS must be placed curbside and tied in bundles not to exceed 4 feet in length or weigh more than 30 lbs.

TRASH FOR COLLECTION should not exceed following dimensions: 10ft. in length; 6 ft. in width; and no more than 4 ft. in height. Smaller items should be in bags that do not exceed 30 lbs.

FOR PICK-UP of major appliances such as washers/dryers and kitchen appliances please call the Village at (845) 425-2805 at least 24 hours in advance. State regulations mandate that doors must be removed from

these appliances or they may not be picked up curbside. Large furniture items should be called in at least 24 hours in advance as well.

RECYCLING will continue to be collected on Wednesday according to published schedule

PLEASE NOTE that regulations do not allow for the pick up of televisions or electronic equipment as part of bulk pickup, all electronic equipment should be brought to the Rockland County Household Hazardous Waste Drop-off Facility at 35 Fireman's Memorial Drive in Pomona.

IN ADDITION, construction materials/debris will not be picked up as part of the Village's

Bulk pick-up program. Please contact Superior Waste at (845) 680-6012 to make private arrangements.

DEFINITION OF MERCHANDISING – Selling, bartering or trading, or offering to sell, purchase, barter or trade any goods, wares, commodities, services, property (real or personal), or other merchandise, including periodicals and books.
