PERMIT APPLICATION TO FILM ON PUBLIC AND/OR PRIVATE PROPERTY FOR COMMERCIAL PURPOSES (RESOLUTION NO. 97-84)

RESOLVED, that the following rules and regulations shall apply to any person, firm or corporation intending to film on Public and/or Private Property for commercial purposes:

- The applicant shall file with the Village Clerk a statement, on its letterhead, setting
 forth the name, address and telephone number of the applicant, the specific location
 and purpose of the proposed filming, the date or dates and hours of proposed filming,
 the number of vehicles to be used with a description of each vehicle, the numbers of
 persons that will participate in the filming, and the name, address and telephone
 number of the person in charge of said filming;
- 2. A fee of \$250. per day for filming on private property or \$250. per hour for filming on public property, payable to the Village of Chestnut Ridge;
- 3. Proof of insurance coverage's for public liability and automobile liability in the minimum amounts of \$1,000,000 for each such liability and \$50,000. property damage. If public property is used for the filming, the Village of Chestnut Ridge shall be named as an additional insured:
- 4. Statement of specific locations at which all vehicles will be parked or stored during the filming; vehicles shall not be parked on streets not approved by the Village nor in front of driveways other than the property at which the filming is to take place;
- 5. Applicant shall notify all adjoining property owners at least 48 hours prior to the date of the proposed filming;
- 6. Applicant shall notify the Town of Ramapo Police Department at least 48 hours prior to the date of the proposed filming;
- 7. All debris, garbage, litter and rubbish must be removed from private and public property used in connection with the filming immediately after each day's filming;
- 8. The person in charge of the filming shall insure that interference or disturbance of persons, property or vehicles not involved in the filming shall be minimal;
- 9. A cash deposit in the amount of \$1,000 shall be posted with the Village Clerk to insurance compliance with these rules and regulations.
